

Children Education Scholarship Program - Children Excursion in February 2011

As a recreational activity for the children a one-day excursion program was organized on the 26th of February. This activity was kindly sponsored by our school partnership students in Austria!

Here is the detailed description of the activities on that day:

From the EcoHimal Nepal side, Mr Narayan Dhakal, Sangita Shakya and myself – Nawaraj Subedi - along with the school principal Mr Bishnu Paudel participated in the program. We started at 8:00 am from the school walking in two lines for girls and boys. School principal was leading the way ahead, Miss Sangita supervised the students in the middle and I was covering the students at the back. Mr. Narayan was taking photos of students. We walked to the Bishnumati river, crossed over the hanging bridge and arrived at the historical centre of Kathmandu, namely the Hanuman Dhoka , Basantapur durbar square and the Kumari temple. Luckily we could see the living goddess Kumari and the children were very happy to see Kumari from up close. We stayed for one and a half hours describing the area and its historical importance. We reached Newroad at 9:30 am and stopped for breakfast in a good hotel. Afterwards we went by taxi to the children's Fun Park. The students played several games there such as train, basketball, boating, electric motorbike riding, etc.

After three hours of playing in the fun park we went to the Durbar Marga by taxis for lunch in Naglo Bakery Café. We were altogether 25 people sitting at a table for lunch and we ordered a variety of dishes according to the taste of the children. All the students were served in turn and Mr Narayan took some photos of them. All the students were very happy and enjoyed their lunch. At 16:00 pm we caught the taxis and came back to the school safely.

Output of the excursion program:

The main goal of the program was to provide some recreation for the students and to upgrade their knowledge about contemporary society and their own environment. As we expected, the children were enthusiastic and very happy with the excursion.
